- A stall charge is 0 yen. (If you sell items, the charge is from 500 to 1000 yen.)

- Please introduce hand craft from your country and teach how to make it.
- You can use a site (2.5m x 2.5m) with three desks, two chairs, and two panels.
- A stall charge is 0yen. (If you charge the fee from customers, the charge is from 500 to 1000 yen.)
